## **Pioneers' Response to COVID-19**

ORLANDO, Fla., March 3, 2020 - Due to the impact of the 2019 coronavirus in countries where our members live and work, Pioneers is taking precautions to prevent the spread of the virus and ensure the safety of our members and the general public.

- We daily monitor and adhere to current recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control.
- We identify the origin of all visitors to our Orlando offices as it relates to affected areas and monitor for any visible symptoms of illness.
- We have suspended all international travel for our U.S. staff through April 25, 2020, and will extend this restriction as needed.
- We have requested that all those planning travel to our office who may have been exposed to the virus or are experiencing cold or flu symptoms postpone their travel plans until a later date.
- We have posted signage in our U.S. office reminding employees to practice proper hygiene and provide hand sanitizer and antiseptic wipes for sanitizing work surfaces.
- We have requested that all U.S. office staff who are experiencing cold or flu symptoms remain at home until they have fully recovered.
