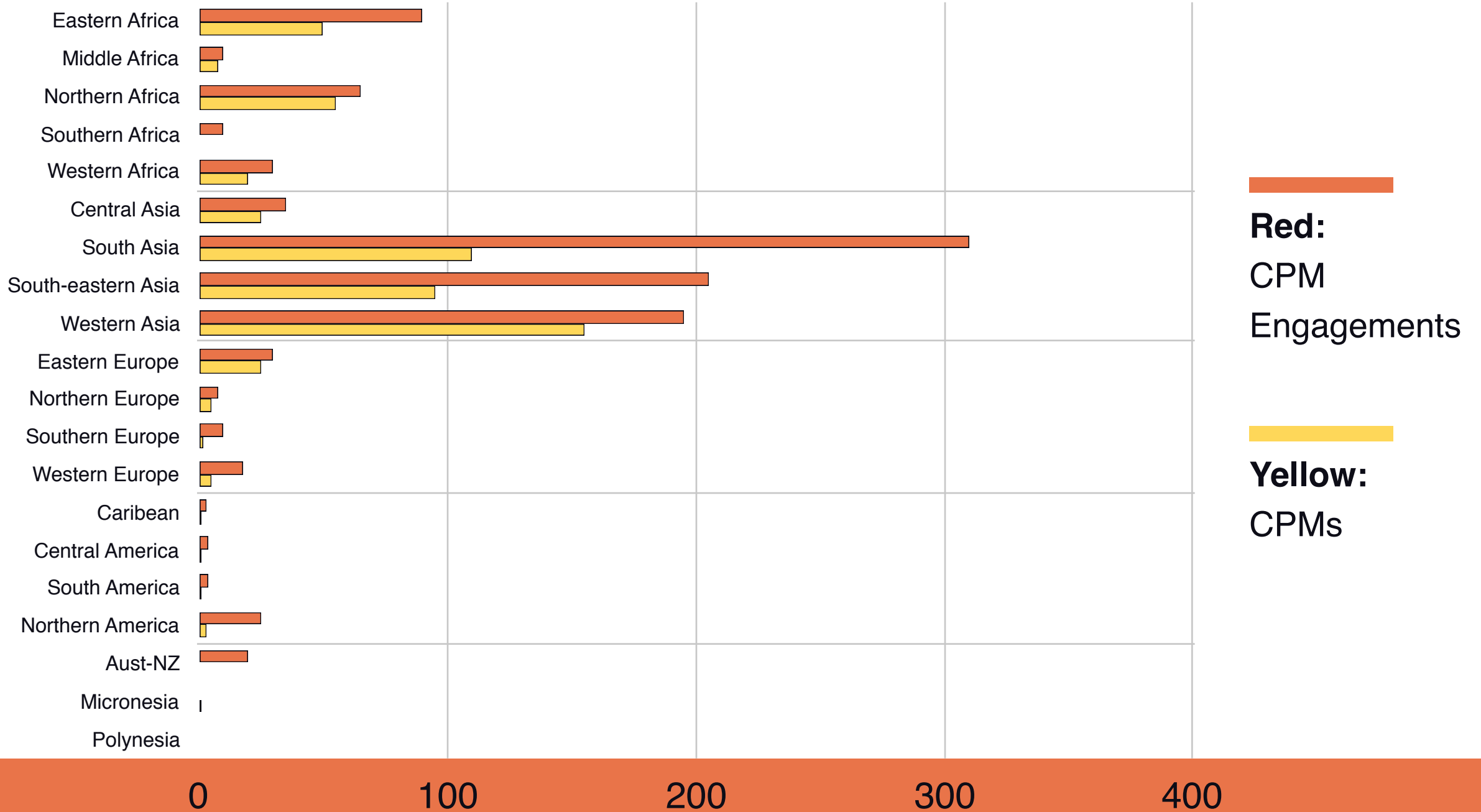
Movement
