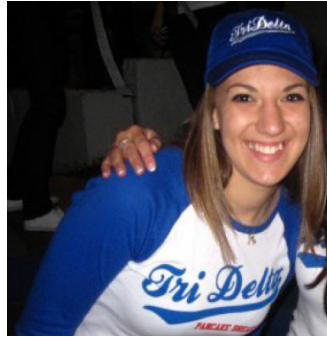
► Family Update ◀
