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Maximizing Your Time As An MPD Coach

Top Three Ways I Maximized Time

- Group Coaching
- Recruiting New Coaches
- Support Raising Summer Assignment

TIME SAVER #1 The Group Coaching Call

- Group coaching adds TIME into your week.
- Group coaching adds COMMUNITY into what is typically isolating MPD work.
- Group coaching enables you to coach MORE people.
- Group coaching means you do not REPEAT yourself multiple times a week!

Sample Group Call Agenda

- Opening Question-Describe your MPD in terms of a gas tankfull and over flowing, half a tank, running on fumes, other?
- **Devotion**-Praying it Safe article by Debbie Barron. Read/discuss how we "pray it safe" in MPD.
- Prayer-I will call on a few of us to pray
- Resource-The Voice Mail Strategy
- **Q & A-**What road bumps are you hitting that we could kick around as a group?

TIME SAVER #2 Recruiting Other Coaches

- NEW Staff who ROCKED the support raising process
- •SENIOR Staff who ROCKED the support raising process
- •Senior staff WORN OUT from 5 days a week campus work
- •MOM's wanting to contribute!

Sample Recruiting Scripts

Talk to Their Director

"Jake has done a knockout job raising his support this Fall. I joked with him that if he kept doing such an awesome job I might recruit him to be a coach one day and he did not totally reject the idea!! Would you be open to me talking more to him about possible being a part-time coach in the future? We could really use the help, even just a few hours a week."

Sample Recruiting Scripts

• Recruit Them Formally After Gaining Permission

After you share with them the reasons you think they would rock as an MPD Coach you could say...

"I want to send you a document called a Position Focus to have you read the expectations of a coach. There is a training you need to attend and a minimum number of people each MPD coach needs to work with and some other items. I think you will totally rock it and wanted you to see it all clearly laid out."

TIME SAVER #3 MPD Summer Assignment

- Typical Summer Project
 - Accept a lot of people
 - Pre project work-flights, packing, passports, etc.
 - Total Immersion
 - Clear start and stop date
 - T-shirts, camaraderie, shared memories
- Typical MPD Summer Project
 - Accept a lot of people-Two coaches help run it and divide responsibilities and weekly reports
 - Pre project work-The God Ask, roleplaying their ministry presentation with a coach, updated MPD \$ goals
 - Total Immersion 40 hours per week, no vacations, no home projects, just MPD
 - Clear start and stop date with a launch call and a celebration ender call
 - T-shirts, camaraderie, shared memories

MPD Summer Assignment

- This is a project they sign up to be on for the summer
- I am the project director
- Every other week group virtual calls-GoToMeeting
- Same 5 item call agenda I use during the year
- Same afternoon of looking at reports and responding to reports over email
- They can raise an average of \$1,279 in monthly support (one summer it was over 2,000!!!!)

Why Save time?

- Free yourself up to have regular MARGINS.
- Give yourself time to dream and TACKLE other projects.
- Keeps BOOTS on the GROUND! Utilizing these tips not only saves us time and frees us up-but it helps our comrades stay on the mission field with full support reaching a lost and dying world!
