A Steward's Perspective

- The Lord owns it all - Ps 24:1
 - Time.
 - Talents (result in position & influence)
 - Treasure
- Our Responsibility to use all those to build His Kingdom - Matt 25 14-30
- Faithfulness leads to true riches - Luke 16:11
- We can not serve two Masters – Matt 6:24

Stewards have a Plan

- Having a plan is expected - Luke 14: 28
 - First priority is pleasing our Master & building His Kingdom
 - Make the most of God's provision
 - Provides motivation to raise support because we know we really need it
 - The decisions are made before we feel the emotion
 - Allows us to minister for a lifetime
 - Encourages our partners and those in our ministry focus
- Slow and Steady Plodding Brings Success – Prov. 21:5

Practice – Practical Tips

- Realistic
- It must include margin (saving) Prov. 21:20 *There is precious treasure and oil in the dwelling of the wise, but the foolish man consumes all he gets*
 - Must give same priority to future needs as current needs
- Must be balanced (Efficiency vs Effectiveness)
- If Married, jointly decided on beforehand, both must understand it
- Used daily for spending decisions

Practice

- Keep it as simple as possible
- Daily tracking (entering) of expenses (tie to an existing habit)
- Automate as much as possible (EFT's etc.)
- Match Budget/Tracking system to how you are wired

- Gain training and experience

- Bring your own journey into the light, Be open about mistakes...
- Use your journey to ask specific questions
- Gather like hearted co-laborers and start dreaming and planning
- Make it part of your New Staff Training
- Regular communication (MPD & Stewardship Nuggets)
