Defining "Us" & "Them"

- •Us: those on this call, the ones that are leading change, making decisions, strategizing MPD within our org, etc.
- •Them: those within our organization that are affected by our decisions, changes, and culture of MPD within our org.
- You could be both!

Stewarding Us

- Are you taking care of you?
- Tyranny of the Urgent vs. Prioritizing
- When we are living in the urgent, there usually isn't any margin for growth.

Stewarding Them

- •Listening well and sometimes becoming the interpreter.
- Prayer
- When making changes, over communicate and actually deliver.
- Gratitude is contagious.

Things You Can Do Today

- Write down things that are broken or are critical areas where things need to change within your organization.
- Who are the ones that can bring about change? Develop a plan and share it with them.
- Are you the one who can bring change? Who is speaking into your organizations MPD strategy? Is it only you? Perhaps there are some blind spots... What can you do to change that?
