## Missionary's MPD Mission

To Mobilize a Team of Ministry Partners  
to be Involved in the Great Commission  
Through their Prayers and Generosity

## People Need to Give (I Chron. 29)

- A Christian's personal devotion to God must result in tangible, visible evidence of an inward change of the Holy Spirit. (I Chron. 29:1-5a.)
- Giving is an intentional, spiritual act. (I Chron. 29:5b-8)
- Missionaries must embrace that asking people to give is a significant spiritual act.
- Giving is about a wholehearted devotion to the Lord. Asking someone to give is about asking him to consecrate himself to the Lord.

## People Need to Give (I Chron. 29)

- The giver needs to give far more than any person or cause has the need to receive.
- Giving has a contagious affect upon others. (I Chron. 29:9)

## People Need to Give (I Chron. 29)

### David's prayer (29:10-20)

- Generous, intentional giving connects people to the heart of God.
- David was delighted that he was able to give. He was thrilled that God gave him all of his wealth just so he could give it back to the Lord.

## People Need to Give (I Chron. 29)

### David's prayer (29:10-20)

- Asking gives the missionary the privilege to be used by the Spirit of God to help call people to use what God has entrusted to them for the kingdom.

## People Need to Give (I Chron. 29)

MPD connects ministry partners to the heart of God.

- Asking people to invest in kingdom work calls them to:
  - Devote themselves more fully to God.
  - Consecrate themselves to the Lord.

## People Need to Give (I Chron. 29)

When we invite people to participate in kingdom work through their prayers and generosity, we give them an opportunity to connect to the heart of God.
